

Atlantic Medical Imaging Physician Operations Meeting Minutes June 9, 2026

Old Business:

- No topics currently

New Business:

- Peer Review Demo for ARMC and AMI
 - Shawn demonstrated the Microsoft Nuance Peer Review system, highlighting its integration with PowerScribe, customizable options for peer review ratings, comment fields, and the ability to export reviews to the ACR. The system allows for both manual and automatic peer review prompts, and reviews can be purged or edited as needed. The group would remain in Fuji for at least another month, with a possible transition to the Microsoft system in late July. Further demonstrations and feedback from section leads and stakeholders will inform the final implementation approach.
- New Radiologist
 - Dr. Nhan Nguyen – Telerad 11 pm – 8 am – October 19, 2026
 - Approved
- Xray2/US2 STATs
 - These are the responsibility of the respective Xray1 and US1 readers and oftentimes are overlooked. Dr. Hota worked with IT and now all Xray2 STATs show up on the Xray1 list, and all U 2 STATs show up on the US1 list.
- Moonlighting: US2/Xray2 PM Reader
 - Cases have been missed that are timestamped from 11 am – 12 pm. Propose changes in QGenda will read:
 - Moon: Read US 2/XRAY 2 AM (8a - 11a)
 - Moon: Read US 2/XRAY 2 PM (11a - 4p)
 - Approved
- PowerScribe One Smart Impression
 - There are problems with smart impressions, such as inaccurate recommendations for lung nodules and FFR CT, and incorrect critical finding notifications with bogus dates and times. Nuance is aware and working on a fix. Nuance advised users to flag problematic cases using the feedback button, which helps tie issues to accession numbers and accelerate algorithm retraining. Partha emphasized the importance of this interim step until a permanent fix is released.

Body:

- MR Body – Monday email
 - A general email is sent on Mondays to remind CT readers to pick up CT cases from the body MRI queue, especially if their own queues are light, to help manage workload and prevent backlogs. If the current approach is insufficient, the group may consider officially assigning CT cases from the body MRI queue to CT readers on Mondays.

WI:

- **Section Chief Update - Dr. Peggy Avagliano**
- Operational changes with MG Updates
 - SecureView Phase-Out and Protocols
 - SecureView will be discontinued in mid-July, urging staff to coordinate with Rajal and Shawn to ensure all protocols are available on Fuji.
 - Monitor QA and Certification
 - Only mammo-approved monitors certified by Jonathan Law and with proper QA documentation can be used for reading, and that offices must address any outstanding QA issues, particularly with certain monitor models.
 - Tomo Unit Upgrades
 - Upcoming upgrades to Tomo units, including HD and slab technology, and changes to imaging protocols that will reduce storage needs. The rollout will begin with non-end-of-life units, starting June 11th in Sicklerville, and will include trials of the new SmartCurve technology.
 - Information Sharing
 - Jennifer offered to share detailed information about the new technologies and installations with the team, and Amy coordinated to have this information posted on the portal.
- Fuji Keyboard
 - Additional Fuji keypads are on backorder and will be distributed on request rather than to every workstation. Peggy and Shawn

encouraged users to adapt to keyboard shortcuts, with Peggy offering to share her custom shortcut guide.

Nuclear Med:

- Hida EF Backorder
 - Switching from Bracco Diagnostic's Kinevac (on backorder) to generic version Sincalide, with a saving of around \$400 per 10 vials ordered.

 - It was reported that lateral lumbar spine Xray's from certain locations consistently exhibit motion artifacts, prompting an investigation into the issue and coordinating with the relevant offices.
