

## MSK Guidelines:

**Radiologist must be present for all MSK Exam-check RAD schedule prior to scheduling**  
**E-mail [MSK@amini.com](mailto:MSK@amini.com) for scheduling**

**CR Steriod Hip Injection:** Xray/fluoro Hip Injection (Any steroid injection or Aspiration)

**US Guide Joint Injection and/or Aspiration Inj:** injections/aspirations/lavage

**SI Joint Injection:** Xray Galloway & Manahawkin, Dr. Saad

**PRP Exam:** Wall and TR37 House Nurse schedules (Dr H Patel only)

**US Soft Tissue Neck:** regular US without injection/aspiration

- Obtain copy of script prior to scheduling. Does script state injection/aspiration.
- Verify one of the following Rad are on schedule
  - Levi
  - H Patel
  - Vu
  - Saad

### **Dr Specific Notes:**

- Vu-performs injections in X-Ray
- Levi-performs injections /aspiration in US. Except Hip Injection, performed in Xray
- Saad- performs injections in Xray and US
- H Patel – performs injections in US Script must state which type of steroid injections. Not required by any Rad

### **Soft Tissue MSK (Upper and Lower):**

- DX includes but not limited to:
  - Achilles tendon
  - Dynamic US for muscles
  - Foot or heel pain
  - Joint fluid- knee or hip
  - Morton's Neuroma
  - Muscle tear/strain
  - Tendonitis/Tendinosis
  - Plantar fasciitis
  - Rotator cuff tear
  - Shoulder calcification
  - Ganglion Cyst
  - Soft tissue lump, swelling/edema or pain
  - Nerve block extremity) (PIN) and Abdomen (ACNES)

### **Soft Tissue Others: Lump/Palp areas**

- Can be scheduled in any offices.
- Body parts:
  - Abdominal Wall-Hernias, Lipoma
  - Chest- NOT Breast related issues ONLY

- Upper Back
- Head/Neck-non-Thyroid related issues
- Lower Back/Flank
- Buttock
- Groin/Inguinal Canal-Hernia, Pseudoaneurysm or Lymph Nodes
