Policy and Procedures:


- Document Management Application – Jen
 - New application was approved, will be used to help manage our documents(policies)/vendor agreements, starting to build in February and will take 6 months.
- ST100 Certification Requirements: BLS, ACLS, ARLS, PALS, and Sedation – Kim Wright

 - Rewrote the policy to include ARLS requirements. It was brought up that if RDI (Inspira locations) start to do CCTA exams they will need to be ACLS certified. Atlanticare does not require ACLS due to code team, but we need to check with Cape regarding their requirements, IR will still require ACLS. Question was asked regarding Mammo/Thyroid Biopsies – we do not use sedation, so ACLS is not required. It is written into the policy that ARLS is approved if they receive approval from an AMI Director. This was approved pending Cape requirements.

 - Comment boxes vs established Imorgon fields
 - Fine tuning Imorgon templates – can we remove the comment field and use the preset Imorgon fields? Comment field does not cross over to Imorgon and sometimes the rad can miss the comment. If we use the preset fields, rads would need to remember to delete the comment otherwise it will appear on the report (remind techs to watch their wording). It was decided that we need to work with Cherry on these templates, meeting to be set up.

- FUJI Hologic Secureview Integration Update

There have been some issues with the feature being turned off, radiologists not logging out at the end of their shift and another radiologist tries to log in the next day.

 - Please note, when you open a case in SecureView... PowerScribe and Fuji will automatically open for that patient on the other monitors; specifically, the Fuji viewer will open; PowerJacket is in the background and can be brought into view by clicking the double file folder picture.
 - **Examples of when Fuji syncing to SecureView is helpful:**
 - Patient has been getting q6 month ultrasounds, Multiview only has 2 of them to view; rad does not realize patient has already finished 2 years of follow up; Fuji lets you see all prior US's
 - Review prior in house or outside non-breast imaging that shows a finding that will help you read your Mammo - i.e., prior CT shows gynecomastia; prior CT shows sternalis muscle corresponding to medial CC view asymmetry, PET/CT or MR abdomen finding.

- Patient has recent outside Mammo's that are not in your SecureView--SecureView shows current and 2020 Mammo, but you see there is a 2021 and 2022 outside Mammo in Fuji viewer. You can have these additional OSF pushed to SecureView.

- PET Tracers Reimbursement Update – Kim Wright
 - 77814 – \$1,752.05
 - 78815 – \$1,763.85
 - 78816 – \$1,764.42
 - A9608 Posluma – \$4,918.25 (As of January 1st)
 - A9586 Amyvid – \$3029.00
 - A9596 Illucix – \$4918.25, we need to buy a 10mil shield \$673 each
 - 4 free doses but we need to buy the syringe shield
 - We are reimbursed the actual cost minus a sequestration write off from Medicare. Kim and Eric need to check with Hemal on Commercial/Medicare Advantage plans reimbursement. Dr. Krynyckyi will create a flow pattern.
