

Email from Jonathan Law:

Hello all,

We are in the process of renewing our Radioactive Material License and you were identified as being active on the "reading" side of nuclear medicine studies.

We can include anyone as an AU if you have been on a RAM license within the last 7 years (will need that license #) or have passed your boards within the last 7 years provided that diploma states "**AU Eligible**". **If your diploma qualifies you, we will need a signed preceptor statement from your residency program director or designee.** I can provide you with the preceptor statement to forward for signature.

You are not required to be an AU for interpretations of nuclear medicine studies.

I am reaching out to you because the license is renewed for 10 years during which time there may be many current AUs who retire, and your 7-year window will expire. There must be active AUs on the license to legally be able to conduct nuclear medicine studies.
